The Executive Steering Committee has the authority and the responsibility to establish, review on an annual basis, regulate, modify or disband all Foundation committees, working groups or task forces, with the exception of the Nominating and Governance Committee and the Executive Steering Committee which are standing committees.

The Executive Steering Committee is empowered to act on behalf of the Board of Trustees, with the same powers as the Board, on all matters brought before it between regular meetings of the Board of Trustees except as prohibited by the law of the jurisdiction in which the Foundation is incorporated. All actions taken by the Executive Steering Committee must be ratified by the Board of Trustees at its next meeting, and any such actions which the Board declines to ratify must be reversed to the extent reasonably possible.

The Executive Steering Committee consists of the President, the three Vice Presidents, and the chair of the Nominating and Governance Committee. The CEO of U.S. Ski & Snowboard is a non-voting ex-officio member of the committee. The President will chair the Executive Steering Committee.
